NATHAN' MERRILL (Abel³) was born 3 Apr. 1676, in New- 3d GENERATION
 bury, Mass., and died in 1742 intestate. He lived in
 that part of the town which was afterward incorporated
 as West Newbury. In a deed from his brother Michael
 in 1721 both are described as weavers. He was a "snow-
 shoe man" in 1700 (see Currier's History of Newbury,
 page 841). He married, 6 Sept. 1699, Hannah Kent, daughter
 of John and Sarah (Woodman) Kent of Newbury, who was born
 13 Sept. 1679, and died 3 Feb. 1753/4. Children, born in
