I give and bequeath to my son Josiah Haskell the Water by side of my Homestead (namely) The piece of Village Land where his Dwelling house & Barn Standeth that is within Fence there, and from off great Rock that is near the way to the ^{of his Barn,} so running to the Barn upon the hill together with the Hill Lott near the Burying Place, and a small pasture called the Hill pasture, adjoining to John Roberts Land, Together with One halfe of my Marsh & Thatch Lott (excepting what Benj: & Thos had) and the one halfe of my Out Land The Above sd Premises shall be to my son Josiah Haskell His heirs & assigns forever with One halfe of y^e fruit of My Orchard for five years & no longer

I do bequeath to my son William Haskell the other part (namely) The Easterly part of my homestead adjoining to Josiah's part, Together with my Dwelling house and Barn, and y^e halfe of my Marsh & Thatch Lott (except what Benj: & Thos had) Together with one halfe of my Out Land; The Above sd premises shall be to My son William his heirs & assigns forever

Lastly I do Make & Ordain & constitute my two sons (namely) Josiah & William Haskell, to be y^e Sole Exec^r of all my other Estate what-soever, whether Express particular or not. And to receive all my just Dues, and to pay all my just Debts, and such Legacies as I shall appoint (namely) To my son in Law David King five Shillings, being y^e remainder in full of my Daughter's Eleazar's portion; and to my Grand Daughter Mary Lay of Sum. of four Pound of paper money within six Months after my Decease And to my Daughter Sarah Bide or her heirs, I do Order my Executor to pay the sum of twenty Pound within six months after my Decease and shall be in full of her portion; and to pay to be in Publick bill of Credit or such Medium of Trade as is passing then Further I do Dispose y^e share of my wife's estate as is following To be my last Will & Testament in Witness Whereof I have subscribed My name and Seal hereunto, on the day of the bearing of my said bequest One Thousand Seven hundred thirty three (1733)

 I Moses Platts of Rowley in y^e County of Essex in New England of lawfull Age, being weak of Body but of perfect Mind & Memory thanks be given to God; Lying on my Death bed & in full view of my Body & Soul do make this My last Will & Testament (First) I give & Recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be decently buried at the Discretion of My Executors hereafter named; and as touching that worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this Life I give, Devise, & Dispose of the same in y^e following Manner and Manner

First I Will that all those Debts & Duties as I do Owe in Right or Conscience, to any person or persons whatsoever shall be well & Truly paid or Ordained to be paid in convenient Time after my Decease by my two Executors hereafter named

I give unto my dearly beloved wife Hannah, The One halfe of my Dwelling house (namely) The Easterly end of it house and halfe of Cellar and one of y^e Owens, during her Natural life, and after her Decease into my son Moses Platts & I give to my eldest son Abel Platts all my land in y^e town of Rowley lawfully granted by y^e General Court to Jos^{ph} Taylor Jos^{ph} & others
