


Charles 1st King of England THAT MAN OF BLOOD meets his End !"

On 30 January 1649 Joseph Pride, pioneer and first resident of Prides Corner, Maine, beheaded the tyrannical King Charles 1st

Charles 1 st is known in history as "that man of Blood" because of the 200,000 violent deaths he caused.

Joseph was 12 years old on the day he Executed the King of England.

In 1660 he fled the Kings son, King Charles 2nd, and hid here in Maine for 26 years while the new King of England and the entire British Empire sought him to kill him.

He emerged 26 years later, a year after Charles 2nd died, to baptize the six children he and Jane Pride succesfully raised on the shores of Highland Lake in the Wilderness of Maine

They traveled with **six small children** on empty winter roads, avoid-ing the Redcoats, to the First Church in Beverly Mass **Dec 12th 1686** for his personal day of victory over monstrous tyranny.
