Trator on the estate of Thomas Blucker ^{deceased} (an Absentee) duly
appointed by the General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts,
for & in consideration of the sum of three hundred
and sixty two dollars & sixty six cents to me in hand
well and truly paid at or before the signing sealing
and delivery of these presents by William Purington
of Dalmouth in the County of Cumberland Esq. the
receipt whereof I the said Henry in my said Capacity do
hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained & sold
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto
the said William Purington & to his Heirs and Assigns
forever, one undivided third part of two hundred & fifty six
acres of Land lying and being in ^{the} said Town of Dalmouth
and is an undivided third part of that tract which was
granted by the Proprietors Committee of Dalmouth to
Brigadier Saml. Waldo. & laid out near the Snake Pond.
The premises having been confiscated to the use of the Com-
monwealth as the property of said Blucker, & sold at
public auction on the first day of October last by order
of the supreme Judicial Court for the payment of said
Blucker's just debts. To have and to hold the said
granted & bargained premises unto the said William his
Heirs and Assigns Executors Administrators & Assigns to his
and their only proper use benefit & behoof forever. And I
the said Henry in my capacity aforesaid do avouch the
Commonwealth to be the true and lawful owners of the
said Land, and have in ^{well known} therefore good right & lawful
authority to dispose of the said Land in manner as
aforesaid, and I do hereby covenant and agree that the
Commonwealth will warrant and defend the said Land
against the lawful claims and demands of all persons
whatsoever unto the said William his Heirs Executors
Administrators and Assigns, and that I have taken the
steps required by law to enable me to sell the same as aforesaid

do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give grant sell and
convey unto Duncan & to his heirs and assigns forever,
fifty acres of Land lying in common & undivided with
others, and is situated in that tract of Land which
was allowed & granted by the Proprietors Committee
of Falmouth to the heirs of Brigadier Gen^l. Willde, out
of their pitch of nine hundred and sixty ^{two} acres lying
near and adjoining the Duck Pond. To have and to
hold the aforegranted premises to the said M^r. Intosh his
heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever.
And I do covenant with the said M^r. Intosh his heirs &
assigns that I am lawfully seized in of the aforegranted
premises, that they are free of all encumbrances, that I
have good right to sell and convey the same unto
the said M^r. Intosh, and that I will warrant & defend
the same premises to the said M^r. Intosh his heirs and
assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands
