the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said

Enos Soule, his heirs and assigns forever, a certain piece and parcel of land, and buildings

known, situated in Pittsford, County of Cumberland, State of Maine, and bounded as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a red Oak tree on the East side of the Duck Pond, adjoining Stephen Huston's land and running South sixty five degrees East, one hundred and sixty rods to the road, then South six & a half E. twenty five rods and ten links, then N. sixty nine E. sixty three rods by said road to the end of the stone wall, then N. two West forty one rods to a stake and stone, then N. twenty one East forty seven rods to George Liddy's land, then South sixty five West one hundred forty three rods to a stake, then South twenty five East, sixty rods & 18 links, then South sixty five West forty eight rods & 7 links to the Pond, then by said Pond to the first corner mentioned, containing two hundred acres more or less, Being the farm and lands now occupied by Mr. Filds, & the same I bought of Marcus Purinton.

Dyer to Soule.

To have and to hold the aforesaid and bargained Premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof, to the said

Enos Soule, his heirs and assigns, to *his* and their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant with the said

Enos Soule, his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the Premises; that they are free of all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said

Enos Soule to hold as aforesaid; and that I and my heirs, shall and will warrant and defend the same to the said

Enos Soule, his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

In Witness Whereof, I the said *Jesse Dyer* and *Mary A. Dyer* wife of the said *Jesse Dyer*

in testimony of her relinquishment of her right of dower in the above described premises, have hereunto set our hands and seals this *fifteenth* day of *August* in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and *sixty four*.
