in consideration of the sum of Six thousand Dollars paid by The Cumberland Bone Company, in the State of Maine, incorporated by the Legislature of Maine, in 1865, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Cumberland Bone Company, their successors

heirs and assigns forever,

a certain parcel of land, within the buildings: Soule
thence, situated in Salmon Falls, in said County of Cumb- to
land, and bounded as follows, viz: Beginning at a red C. B. Company,
Oak tree on the East side of the Duck Pond adjoining
Stephen Weston's land, and running South 68° East one
hundred and sixty rods to the road, thence North 61° East twenty
five rods and ten links, thence North 69° East sixty three rods
to said road, to the end of the stone wall, thence North 2°
West forty one rods to a stake and stone, thence North 21° East
forty seven rods to land of George Liddy, thence North 65° West
one hundred and forty three rods to a stake, thence North 25°
East thirty rods and eighteen links, thence North 65° West forty
eight rods and seven links to the Pond, thence by said pond
to the bounds first mentioned, containing two hundred acres, more
or less, according and intending to convey the premises conveyed to me by the
Warrant, deed of Jure Dignit dated August 16 A. D. 1864, and recorded in
Cumberland Registry of Deeds, Book 328, Page 527.

To have and to hold the aforegranted and bargained Premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof, to the said Cumberland Bone Company, their successors heirs and assigns, to their use and behoof forever.

And I do covenant with the said Cumberland Bone Company, their successors heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises; that they are free of all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said

Cumberland Bone Company to hold as aforesaid; and that I and my heirs shall and will warrant and defend the same to the said Cumberland Bone Company, their successors heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

In Witness whereof, I the said Emos Soule and Sarah E. Soule wife of the said Emos Soule do hereby testify of her relinquishment of her right of dower in the above described premises, have hereunto set out hands and seals this twenty second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five.
