# Know all Men by these Presents, That

I, Charles D. Knight of Deering, in the County of Cumberland  
and State of Maine

in consideration of One Dollar paid by  
Ulysses R. Gidel of Falmouth, County & State aforesaid

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said  
Gidel, his

heirs and assigns forever, a certain woodlot situated in said Falmouth, Knight  
and bounded as follows: Beginning at the Easterly corner of to  
ten acres of land belonging to the late Thomson Huston, thence Gidel  
North sixty eight degrees West forty rods, thence North twenty  
one and one-half degrees East sixteen rods and eleven links  
to Paul Huston's land, or land formerly belonging to the  
late Paul Huston, thence on said Huston's land South  
sixty eight degrees East forty rods to land formerly belonging  
to the late Nathaniel Brighton, thence South twenty one  
and one-half degrees West sixteen rods and eleven links to  
the first bounds, containing four acres more or less.

To Have and to Hold the aforegranted and bargained premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof, to the said  
Gidel, his  
heirs and assigns, to their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant with the said  
Gidel, his  
heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises; that they are free of all  
incumbrances;

that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Gidel  
to hold as aforesaid; and that I and my heirs, shall and will warrant and defend the same to the said  
Gidel, his  
heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
